FOREWORD

Dear colleagues, members of Croatian Quality Managers Society (CQMS), scientists and experts in the field of management systems, dear friends, it is my pleasure to invite you to actively participate in the 25th International Symposium on Quality, under the title QUALITY - YESTERDAY, TODAY, TOMORROW. We have been using this title since the 20th symposium and we have decided that since then all subsequent symposiums have the same name.

CQMS was founded on July 3rd, 1996. It has over 150 members from the country and abroad. The goal of CQMS is to bring together experts in the field of quality to develop, promote and disseminate policies and develop quality management systems in accordance with the requirements of international standards ISO 9000, ISO 14000, and others. The task of CQMS is to improve the theory, practice and culture of quality, scientific and professional work in the field of quality management and to advocate for a more complete implementation.

More than 1,100 authors from about 40 countries have participated with around 920 scientific and professional papers published in proceedings. Senior sponsors of the 10th symposium held in March 2009 in Zadar, the 15th symposium held in 2014 in Zagreb and the 20th symposium held in 2019 in Pula, were the then presidents of Republic of Croatia. President Stjepan Mesić personally opened the 10th symposium in 2009 in Zadar.

Since 1997, when the first symposium was held in Duga Uvala, we have held symposia in: Opatija 3 times, Vodice 3 times, Trogir, Zadar 3 times, Šibenik, Baška, Plitvice 2 times, Sv. Martin na Muri, Osijek, Solin, Rovinj, Zagreb, Pula, Crikvenica (online), Poreč 2 times (hybrid) and this 25th again, for the second time, in Šibenik.

CQMS brings together scientists and experts, quality, environment, safety, risk managers and auditors, consultants and all others who directly or indirectly deal with quality issues, with the aim of:

- creating opportunities for a common approach to quality improvement,
- organized action to promote and popularize the quality of the management system,
- spreading the culture of quality,
- protection of professional interests of members,
- raising scientific and professional staff in the field of quality management.

CQMS and its members operate in the spirit of affirming the principles of quality management and improving the market economy, social responsibility, and general democratization of society.

CQMS members are prominent scientists and experts in the field of management systems and others: vice-rectors and deans of faculties, prominent university professors, politicians, top managers, directors of numerous institutions and agencies and practitioners who promote quality management principles in various activities in their companies and other organizations. Among our members there are prominent members of international organizations for quality, among others, EOQ – European Organization for Quality, ASQ – American Society for Quality, IAQ – International Academy for Quality.

In its work so far, CQMS has launched several initiatives aimed at increasing the competitiveness of the economy and better positioning of the Republic of Croatia on the international market.

As before, CQMS, by organizing the 25th international symposium on quality, is making an effort to gather a critical mass of knowledge and competence in the field of management systems in order to contribute to the development of awareness of the need for a more significant implementation of quality management principles and the *Quality Manifesto for the 21st century*, in modelling development concept compatible with all economic systems. Thus, designed development contributes to the competitiveness of the economy as a prerequisite for ensuring a better quality of life for its citizens, which is the essence of the policy of all democratic systems. Especially in the new conditions when quality management systems established in individual entities are no longer sufficient to achieve global quality goals, but the implementation and quality management system should be directed towards public administration holders and communities.

The problem of climate change and the growing degree of commitment of key factors to take measures to mitigate the damage in the coming decades, are areas that require additional resources, including the overall knowledge of mankind.

The current global geopolitical situation, consequences of climate change, disruptions in the development of global supply chains and global logistical problems threaten the achieved level of quality of life of all people on the planet and represent a threat to global balance and peace. In the history of civilization so far, the key word was "competitiveness". It brought material well-being to humanity and the spiritual values that surround us. But it also brought global imbalances that cause conflicts, inequality, migration, and wars. It is becoming more and more evident that the concept of unlimited economic growth will not be possible in the future in the way it has been. We are in a period when it is necessary to find a new key word that will determine the future of civilization. That key word could be "collaboration". In this context, certain concepts of quality are also changing. Understanding the context and accepting quality as a global strategy are prerequisites for re-establishing global balances and increasing the level of quality of life for everyone on the planet.

Unlike any political program, quality as a business philosophy and practical approach promotes management principles that are acceptable to everyone and enables a better quality of life for everyone. In this context, the *Quality Manifesto for the 21st century* was created by the IAQ – International Academy for Quality, as a framework for action to order to raise the level of quality of life for everyone. The *Quality Manifesto* has been accepted by numerous organizations around the world and has been translated into numerous languages.

We are organizing the 25th symposium in the Šibensko-kninska County, in the city of Šibenik. Welcome to Šibenik, a city that changed its vision and strategy twenty years ago and successfully transitioned from an industrial city with economic, environmental and other problems into a recognizable tourist and cultural centre, one of the few cities in the world that has two cultural monuments under the protection of UNESCO.

Paper title, key words and abstracts of papers written in Croatian (Serbian, Bosnian, Montenegrin) shall be translated in English.

Authors shall give the following data: name and surname, profession and title, name, place and country of the company or institution in which they are employed, and their e-mail address.

The Proceedings will be published with the ISSN number issued by the Croatian National and University Library. All published papers will have the CIP cataloguing in the publication and DOI. The Proceedings is referred to in secondary publications JEL classification – Journal of Economics Literature, EconLit, Pittsburg, USA and CAB Abstracts and/or Global Health Databases and Crossref and is in the process of being included in the Scopus database.
